RULES OF PLAY

Rules of play:

- (i) Participants must be in Saskatchewan to purchase tickets.
- (ii) The purchase price of tickets is: \$10 for 1 ticket, \$20 for 4 tickets, \$50 for 25 tickets, \$100 for 100
- (iii) The number of tickets being made available for sale will be limited to 60,000
- (iv) The date(s), time(s), and location(s) of the draw(s) will be 1:00 PM, October 1 2020, 15 Woodlawn Place, Regina SK, S4S 5M9
- (v) The draw will be conducted by Random Number Generator and the winner announced to all participants via electronic notification.
- (vi) There will be only one prize drawn for.
- (vii) The Prize will be 50% of the gross sales to a maximum prize of \$50,000
- (viii) Conditions affecting ability to win or claim prizes, including but not limited to:
 - a. Tickets may only be purchased by participants physically located in Saskatchewan
 - b. Ticket purchasers must use a valid email address to purchase tickets and claim prizes.
 - c. Prize will be delivered by Saskatchewan SPCA (SSPCA), Provincial Association of Transition Houses and Serv of Saskatchewan (PATHS), Saskatchewan Towards Offering Partnership Solutions to Violence (STOPS)
 - d. Members of the organization involved in the conduct and management of the raffle are prohibited from purchasing tickets

Unclaimed Prizes:
